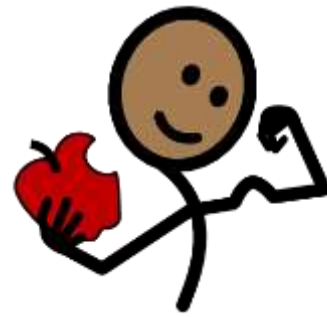


COVID Pooled Testing at My School





Our school will start something new to help keep us safe and healthy.



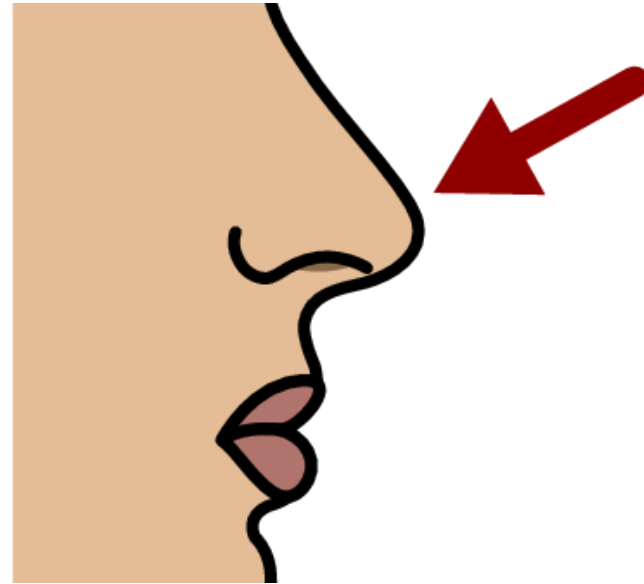
Each week that I come to school, my nurse will give me a COVID test. I will get tested even if I feel okay. This is to help keep everyone at school safe and healthy.



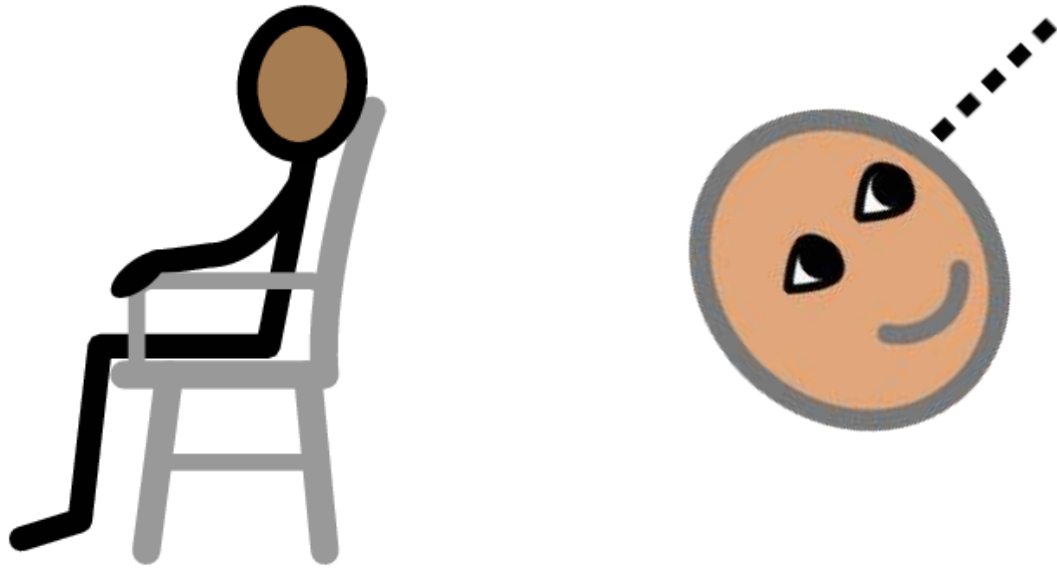
When it is time for my test, I will see Nurse Grottkau. She will wear special clothes to stay safe. Here are some things that she might wear.



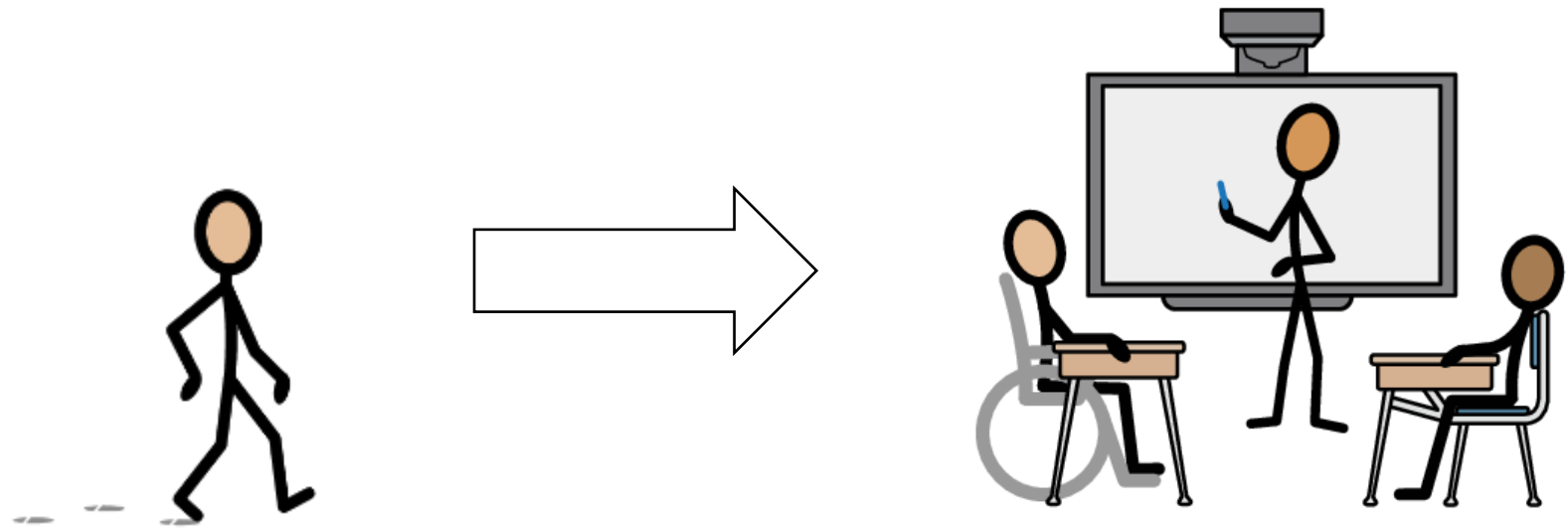
Nurse Grottkau might look different, but she is still my nurse. Mrs. Grottkau is here to help.



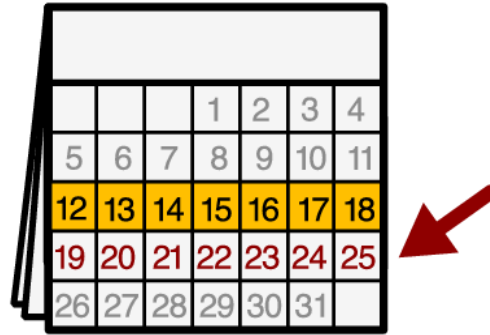
First, I will blow my nose. Then, I will wash my hands or use hand sanitizer. After, the nurse or I will put a Q-tip into my nose.
