

7/21/20 RMHS Fall Sports and Activities Update 1

Good afternoon Reading Families,

Hope you and your families are doing well. We are trying to keep you informed regarding Fall Sports and Activities as soon as we get more information. The MIAA met yesterday Tues 7/21/20 and approved the following motions. We are waiting for guidance from the Governor Baker, EEA, Reading Board of Health, Superintendent Doherty, DESE, and the Reading School Committee.

- 1) **MIAA Approved on 7/21/20:** The MIAA COVID-19 Task Force recommends compliance with the forthcoming joint guidelines published by DESE and EEA (Executive Office of Energy & Environmental Affairs) regarding fall season and K-12 sports.

- 2) **MIAA Approved on 7/21/20:** The MIAA COVID-19 Task Force recommends the MIAA BOD adopt Sept 14, 2020 as the start date for fall sports that are allowed to be played in accordance with the forthcoming DESE and EEA guidelines.

*This is the start date for pre-season of the sports determined viable to play at this time.

- 3) **MIAA Approved on 7/21/20:** The MIAA COVID-19 Task Force recommends the MIAA BOD convenes a meeting three (3) business days after the release of the forthcoming joint guidelines published by DESE and EEA to discuss the fall season and consider additional recommendations from the COVID-19 Task Force.

This is the information we have as of 7/21/20. Due to Covid-19 this is a fluid situation and it could change at any time. Please reach out with any questions.
