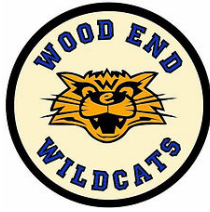


PTO Meeting Agenda

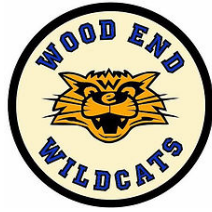
